
Service and fellowship would be the focus for this year

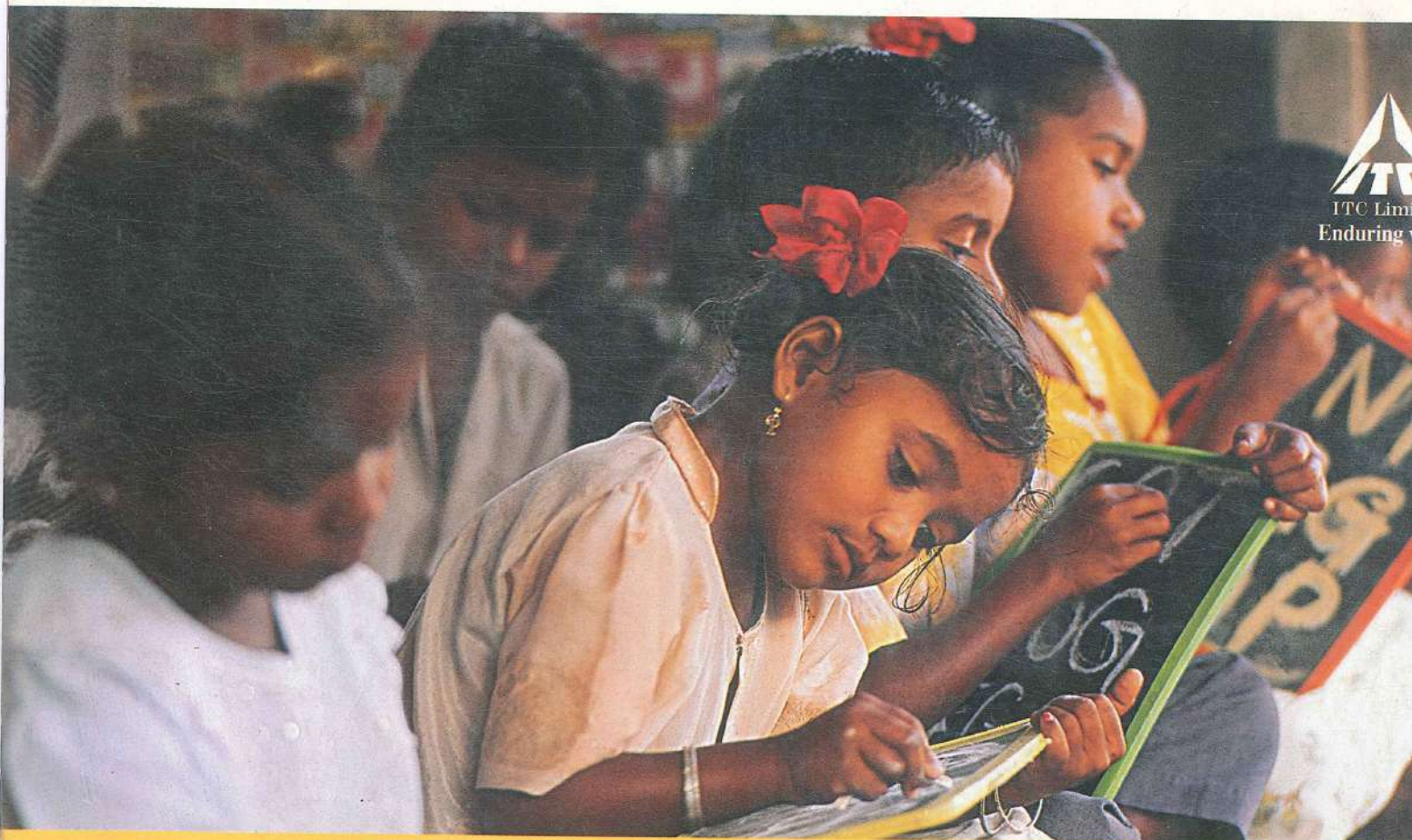
