**Details of Activities:**


Inner Wheel Club of Coimbatore celebrated Breast Feeding week at different places in Coimbatore. The Inaugural Function of Breast Feeding Awareness Campaign was held at Masonic Hospital on 1<sup>st</sup> August 2014. We provided snacks and Tea for all the participants and provided Horlicks and Biscuits to the children. We conducted a Healthy Baby Contest for the children with the support of Hospital Staff and three prizes were given away. The Doctors of the hospital enlightened the mothers present there regarding the importance of Breast Feeding which was well received by them. There were around 100 participants in this campaign and this project was well covered by local Tamil Newspapers – Dinamalar, and Dinathanthi.

On 2<sup>nd</sup> August we had a campaign at Info Engineering and Management College at Sathy Road with the help of the Managing Director and Secretary of College. We organized this campaign for the benefit of post graduate students and faculty of this college. Rtn. Dr. Sridharan Iyer and Dr. Annapoorni from Rao Hospital created this awareness program in an excellent manner. 
### 10.3.6 Brake



Thruster brakes are suitable for 400/440V, 3Ph A.C. Supply for a wide range of drum sizes. 100mm to 600mm dia.

The base is of rigid welded construction. Brakes are also of fabricated construction with robust design. Brake are self aligning, easy removable high grade cast iron fitted with best quality fabric linings. The operating lever is of rigid steel plate construction. The tie rod of a main action, securely fixed in a lug and prevented frame relatives movement with a lock nut. The tie rod transmits the spring force on shock by single lever system. The guide rod is fixed to the base/lever by suitable lugs and the springs are held in place by the guide rids and guide plates. The springs are used depending upon the brake size and thruster capacity so as to obtain the required braking torque.

### 10.3.7 Installation of Limit Switch



If applicable, install limit switches per the following instructions

The limit switches are designed to shut off the power to the rotation drive motor in a clockwise or counter clockwise direction and are not to serve as a spotting function. Two limit switches are mounted on the safety channel at the rear of the head assembly.

Each switch has an adjustable roller-type lever arm and is actuated by a limit switch ramp which must be attached to the mast pipe. The limit switch ramps must be field located, by the installer, to shut off power at the desired clockwise and counterclockwise points. The switches are prewired into the control panel of the jib crane and require no additional electrical hook-up.




Selecting the right audience for creating the awareness, through not difficult but to gain access to them could be a challenge. ### 10.3.5 Motor



Electric motor should be protected against drops of water, oil etc. Terminal boxes should be carefully closed. Electric motor should be periodically inspected and cleaned. Before inspection the motor should be cleaned of dirt and dust and slip ring box should be cleaned.

When checking contact rings and brush holders it is necessary to remove metal and coal dust from the box. The rings are wiped with cotton cloth. If there is no dust or oil on the ring cloth should be sealed in petrol. 'Scratched' rings can be polished with fine emery papers.

When inspecting brush holder it is required to check brushes pressure on the rings and smoothness of the arm motion. Worn-out brushes should be replaced by spare ones.

Bearings of motors should be checked and washed with petrol and lubricant changed every 8 to 12 months.

Lubricant should be added 3 to 6 months, as becomes clear in the course of operation. It should be noted that lubricant fills no more than 2/3rd of grease box.

### 10.3.3 Earth Of Crane

Make sure that phasing of crane power supply is correct.

Controller marked down, if hook move upwards interchange the connection of two phases in the relevant connector panel on the crab. Maintaining electrical control devices means watching out for mechanical problems, not electrical ones. Most control devices have moving parts. Early correction of trouble will avoid high maintenance or replacement costs later.

The most common form of industrials electrical control is a motor, starter, which is a device or groups of device designed to govern in some pre- determined manner, the electric power delivered to the motor.

It regulates the performances of the motor and affords a measure of protection to the drive and the operator. Problems with control equipment can usually be traced to improper application, faulty insulation or an inadequate electrical system.

Improper application results in the wrong overload relays for high inertia starting, wrong wiring connections, wrong capacity such as failure to debate and starter for jogging duty, wrong enclosures, particularly in severe dust locations, and locations, and wrong starting voltage for equipment.

Mounting the equipment in improper location can cause much trouble. One starter in a cement mill was installed below the cement hopper. The abrasive, non - conducting cement dust thoroughly clogged the starter, causing the overload relays to trip out unnecessarily.

At another plant the starter was mounted on a wall which had a severe vibration. As a result the overload relays frequently tripped the starter contacts. In each of these installations the starters were moved to another location and working satisfactorily.


### 10.3.4 Low Voltage

Low voltage is a command source of trouble, especially on smaller systems. It can show up either in starting of running, the motor will draw a higher current. Causing frequent tripping of the overload relay. It may also drop to the point where the contactor may ride back on the springs of the overload relay. 

### 10.3.1 Electric Wiring



During transport a number of electric cables have to be disconnected and these have to be reconnected for this work the fitter will require.

- Electrical panel layout


### 10.3.2 “Earthing” Of Electrical System



The crane structure, motor frame and metal case of electrical equipment are earthen. An earth wire must be installed together with the crane power supply and connected to a connection box at end one of the runway. From this box cable are connected to the bare copper conductors along the runway and earth in connected to the earth conductor of the 4 wire down shop leads, otherwise earth is connected to runway rail as it generally accepted that for normal conditions the crane wheels can be considered to make an effective with the rails.



#### 10.2.4 Drum And Pulleys



During inspection of the rope drum and pulleys one must check condition of the surface of grooves and flanges, proper functioning of the lubricating system, free turning of pulleys on their reliability of fastening of the bearing and axles.

#### 10.2.5 Friction Clutch


During normal operation, adjustment to compensate for friction lining wear may be necessary. The frequency of these adjustments will be dependent on the frequency of overloads occurring. The clutch torque adjustment method is dependent on the clutch type which is determined by whether the crane is used indoors (without a wind load) or outdoors (with a wind load).

#### 10.2.6 Clutch Torque Adjustment - Cranes Used Indoors

Loosen the locking screw on the adjusting nut. Using the hook wrench provided, turn the adjusting nut counter clockwise until the drive sprocket can turn freely in the clutch. The clutch can now be retightened to the proper torque setting. Turn the adjusting nut clockwise until it is hand tight. Using the hook wrench provided, tighten the adjusting nut an additional two full revolutions. After the adjustment is made, tighten the locking screw to ensure that the adjusting nut doesn't loosen. The proper torque setting is achieved when the drive sprocket will not slip under normal operating conditions.

#### 10.2.7 Clutch Torque Adjustment - Cranes Used Outdoors

Back off the disc spring set screws. Turn the adjusting nut clockwise until the disc spring stacks touch the control element. Retighten all disc spring set screws until they are flush with the adjusting nut. The proper torque setting is achieved when the drive sprocket will not slip under normal operating conditions.
