Breast Feeding Awareness Week Program 1-7 Aug. 2004

Our members, keen to spread the message of Exclusive Breast feeding had lined up more than the mandatory 7 projects to be conducted between Aug. 1 – 7, that we had to start the Program a day earlier on 31st July itself, than the prescribed date of Aug. 1st.

Day 1 - 31st July, Saturday

Senior Gynecologist Dr. Padmashri from Rao Hospital, spoke for 25 min. on **Breast feeding: Benefits to babies.** 75 meters of khaki material for stitching the school uniforms costing Rs.3750.00 and Rs. 3000.00 for note books was donated. The total cost amounted to Rs.7,500.00

Day 2 – August 1st, Sunday

A slide was made with short and crisp points on the benefits of breast feeding and exhibited at Maruthi Theatre, between Aug. 1st to Aug 7th. The blockbuster Hollywood movie “Spiderman 2”, with 4 shows per day, was screened during that time. An amount of Rs.3000.00 was spent for the entire project.

Day 3 – August 2nd, Monday

At the Neo Natal Ward at the General Hospital at 10.00am, 56 pregnant women and 27 new mothers assembled at the venue. Dr. Geethanjali from the Pediatric Ward and Head of the Department of Pediatrics Dr. Anuradha, spoke in detail about the advantage of Breast feeding. The Nursing students from R. V.S. College of Nursing, Sular put up a skit. Our Club donated 50 meters of curtain material amounting to Rs. 2500.00.


