
Conclusion :





Honoring the Freedom Fighters





BIO DATA of Mr.V.R.JAGANNATHAN

Mr.V.R.Jagannathan was born on 5th June 1920. He lost his father at a tender age of 6 months. He studied at the Ramakrishna Vidhyalaya at Perianaicken Palayam. He lost his mother when he was studying in the 8th standard. He had to stop his studies then, to take care of farm lands.

In 1931, his grandmother and aunt, who were followers of Mahatma Gandhi, took active part in the freedom movement. Mr.V.R.Jagannathan followed their footsteps and became a freedom fighter. He joined the "Quit India Movement" and followed Gandhiji's principles. After dropping out of school, he along with his friends taught the downtrodden people in the village.

He had the opportunity of meeting Gandhiji during his visit to Palani in 1938. He also met Rajaji, Dr.Rajendra Prasad and Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel during his visits to Ramakrishna Vidhyalaya. He was elected as a congress leader in 1939.

He visited all the nearby villages and spread the message of freedom and urged the people to join the movement. In 1941, with Gandhiji's consent he headed the "Non Cooperative Movement" in Coimbatore.

Following Gandhiji's principles and instructions he along with other freedom fighters marched from Vaiampalayam village to Chennai. The procession moved from village to village, campaigning for freedom and lived on the food offered by villagers. They didn't carry money or valuables with them but only the great spirit of fighting for freedom. They marched ahead despite being threatened by police. They were arrested as soon as they reached Chennai and went through rigorous imprisonment for 3 months.

He got married to Ms.Saraswathi in 1943 and pursued his involvement in the freedom movement until India was declared independent. He was instrumental in starting the Swathanthra Higher Secondary School on 15th August 1947 to commemorate free India. He took keen interest in establishing the school.

He is currently the managing trustee of the school.
