Classroom Reminders

Please keep your child and/or self home if exhibiting ANY cold/flu/Covid symptoms, including but not limited to fever, cough, runny nose, headache or generally not feeling well. If your child is recovering from illness but still showing symptoms, we need a doctor's note with current symptoms and the date they may return to school. We understand that we are more strict than public elementary schools, but our goal is to keep the children and parents in our program healthy. **If your child needs medication to feel well enough for school, they**

should be kept home. We will call you to pick up your child if they seem off or have symptoms. In addition, if a child is unable to mostly cover their mouth or is spreading saliva/mucus around the class, we will call you to pick up.

Please help us respect the learning environment of the classroom by keeping adult conversations to a minimum. Involve the students in conversations that are happening and encourage preschool appropriate dialog, keep cell phone use to a minimum.

Parents who are in tune with what is happening in their child's preschool classroom are better able to establish a connection between what is learned at school and what takes place in the home. This connection is a key component of a child's development and supports further learning.

You have chosen a unique parent co-operative preschool for your child. That means that you, the parents are crucial to the operation of our school, your child's development and our

classroom. Not only do we need you to help maintain our low child to adult ratios, but your child wants you in the classroom. Our children are so excited to share their day with you and you get to be directly involved in your child's early education. We need YOU to help guide our program into 2026!


Board Positions/Job Descriptions

President- The President presides over monthly business meetings and acts as a liaison between staff, board members and membership.

Vice President- Assists the President in their duties and coordinates school fundraising events.

Secretary- Takes minutes at membership meetings and helps keep school records.

Assistant Treasurer- Uses Brightwheel to help track tuition and fundraising expenses.



Work Party Coordinator- Oversees outdoor and indoor maintenance and makes sure all TNS families are signed up to work one work party per year.

Scheduling Coordinator- Schedule the parent's participation and snack schedules on a rotating basis and makes sure each family has a copy each month.

Public Relations (Community Liaison)- Creates social media posts for TNS Facebook & Instagram pages highlighting news and events from the school. Helps publicize the school, coordinates community booths. Creates posts several times a month to keep engagement up.

Historian- Manages online photo folders and creates an annual yearbook for TNS families and students.
