We are looking forward to starting a new year here at Turlock Nursery School! A few housekeeping reminders before we start the new year.

- Please do not leave any children unattended in a vehicle during drop-off or pick-up.
- Any person planning on working in the classroom must have required immunizations and paperwork on file (i.e.grandparents).
- Expect notifications to join Brightwheel. We will begin using this application this year for billing, sign-in, communications and more.

August Themes

Our first few weeks will be spent getting to know each other! Our class theme will be **Nursery Rhyme Weeks** Aug 15th-19th. We will have fun with rhymes, dramatic play, manipulatives, art and more. We will also dive into friendships and kindness

at our school. Children will be introduced to the structure of our day here at TNS and have a chance to explore.

August 22nd-Sept. 2nd our theme will be **Butterfly Weeks**. We will learn about metamorphosis and hopefully we will be able to watch a monarch caterpillar turn into a chrysalis and then a beautiful butterfly we can release!

What does parent participation look like?

As each class begins, the children proceed to wherever and whatever their brain is directing them. The preschool, inside and outside, is filled with opportunities and materials for the children to engage with. The responsibility of the Teachers and Parents is to create a rich environment for the children, to arrive on time, ready and prepared to supervise their play as the children immediately fill every part of the preschool – inside the preschool and in the play yard.

We believe that having parents share in the experience of TNS is the best way to support the whole child. We ask parents to work 1 or 2 days a month (depending on your plan) in the classroom. Parents


are scheduled during the same school hours as their child.
