1. Approval of Previous Minutes

- Emillie Shackelford moved to approve the minutes.

2. Teacher Jamie's Update

- Teacher Jamie provided an update on class capacities and activities:
 - The Tuesday-Thursday class is full.

3. Financial Report

 - Expenses for tree work amounted to \$8,000.
 - Mentioned a donation that prevented a deficit.

- There will be a follow-up to ensure correct expense filing.

4. Student Enrollment
