PLEASE ACCEPT THIS AS A NOTICE TO INFORM YOU, as a property owner, tenant or interested citizen, that the Council of The City of San Diego, California will conduct a public hearing, as part of a scheduled City Council meeting, on the following project:

An appeal to the environmental determination made for the Klauber Development. The Environmental Analysis Section (EAS) of the Development Services Department (DSD) determined that this project meets the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) State Guidelines section 15183 (Projects Consistent with a Community Plan or Zoning). The project would be consistent with the development density established in the Southeastern San Diego (SESD) and Encanto Neighborhoods Community Plan Update (CPU) Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR). Once the environmental determination was made, a Notice of Right to Appeal (NORA) was posted on June 13, 2024. An appeal on the environmental determination was filed on June 25, 2024.

The CEQA analysis was part of a Process 4 Neighborhood Development Permit, Tentative Map, and Site Development Permits that proposes 25 single dwelling units on 25 lots by subdividing four existing lots located at 1362 Klauber Avenue. The 5.66-acre site is located in the RS-1-2 Base Zone of the Encanto Neighborhoods Community Plan area.

The City Council will only be taking action on the environmental appeal and not the project.

The decision of the City Council is final.
