Total cost for E-One (Manufacturer) EMAX 4WD Pumper including sales tax is \$874,824.77. E-One is a member of the joint purchasing group Sourcewell. H&E has advised of a pending 3-4% price increase.

Our current quote can be held with an "Intent to Contract" letter from the Fire Chief authorized by the Board, until the formal bid presentation to the Board which is scheduled for the next regular Board meeting (Thursday, January 27, 2022). At that time the Board can elect to withdraw or proceed with a purchase contract without penalty.

Dave Burkhart made a motion that the Board allow the Fire Chief to send a Letter of Intent to Contract to H&E Equipment Services. Bruce Dow seconded the motion and it passed with three ayes.

Chief Wisner presented a draft Letter of Intent. Chief Wisner signed the letter as authorized, and Board Clerk Bob Papke attested the same.
