

**NORTHWEST CLAY UTILITY DISTRICT**  
**APPLICATION FOR WATER SERVICE**

I hereby request the Northwest Clay Utility District to provide water service at the Property known as:

**APPLICANT AGREES TO:**

1. Pay the applicable connection fee and/or tap fee.
2. Connect to the water system at the meter installed to serve the above property and install and be fully responsible for their own service line from the meter to the place of actual water use.
3. Begin using water immediately after being notified that water is available.
4. Comply with the District's bylaws, rules and regulations, and policies. Pay each bill promptly at such rates, time, and place determined by the District's governing body, the initial minimum bill will be \$15.23 but is subject to adjustment as determined by the District.
5. Comply with all requirements of the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation.
6. Grant the District the right of egress and regress necessary for the District to successfully operate and maintain its water lines and appurtenance.
7. No other present or future source of water will be connected to any water lines served by the District's waterlines and will disconnect from the present water supply prior to connecting to and switching to the District's system and shall eliminate their present or future cross connections in the Applicant system.

**DISTRICT AGREES TO:**

1. Seek adequate financing sufficient to provide a safe, sanitary, and adequate water distribution system to all applicants if economically feasible.
2. Furnish and install a tap into the District's main lines and a complete water meter installation at, or near, the applicant's property line as good engineering practices dictate.
3. Operate and maintain the water system so as to provide water to users in a businesslike, adequate, and nondiscriminatory manner.

**MUTUAL AGREEMENTS:**

1. System is installed: Applicant will be responsible to pay the minimum bill for a period of five (5) years. In case of default, to reactivate the connection, all minimum water bills must be paid to date or a new connection and tap fee will be charged, which being the less.
2. System not installed, or for any reason it is not feasible to serve the applicant at his property line, the connection fee will be refunded to the applicant.
3. The District shall determine the allocation of water to Customers in the event of a water shortage; and may discontinue service to a Customer who allows a connection or extension to be made to the Customer's service line for the purpose of supplying water to another user. In the event the total water supply shall be insufficient to meet all of the needs of the Customers, or in the event of a water shortage, the District may prorate the water available to meet all the needs of the various Customers, on such basis as is deemed equitable by the Board of Commissioners, and may also prohibit or curtail use of water for purposes other than domestic use. If, at any time the total water supply shall be insufficient to meet all the needs of the Customers, the District must first satisfy all of the needs of the Customers for domestic purposes before supplying any water for other purposes.
4. No assurance is made as to volume, pressure, or hydraulics at this location and this agreement is made with applicant having been cautioned as to such possible limitations. The District shall be held harmless and shall not be liable in any way for lack of volume and/or pressure.
