Why Did Jesus Have to Die?

Bible study based on Adam Hamilton's book

Our Lenten Bible study will begin on **Sunday, February 1, at 3:00 p.m.** in the J Ray Stuart Sunday school room. We will wrestle with the question, "Why Did Jesus Have to Die?" using the book by the same title by Rev. Adam Hamilton. There will be six sessions, about 90 minutes each allowing time for Hamilton's video presentation and class discussion.
