With your continued support, we will renovate and expand the farm's core infrastructure — creating an indoor/outdoor programming space, making the farm accessible to everyone, expanding our farm store, and providing year-round facilities that will help us serve more people more effectively.

Like the purchase of Sandy Beach a century ago, this is a once-in-a-generation opportunity — to secure a community treasure and invest in its future.

We've come so far. Let's finish what we started — and ensure Holly Hill Farm continues to grow and inspire for generations to come.

Holly Hill Farm's roots run deep! The land has been farmed continuously since the early 1600s and prior to that time by Massachusog and Wampanoag Peoples. Since 2002, our non-profit has farmed and taught on this historic land, leased with love and generosity from the White family, whose stewardship of this land stretches back to the mid-1800s. Thanks to the incredible generosity of supporters, we have raised enough to purchase the land in 2026 (Step 1)!

With your continued support, we will create new spaces that enable year-round learning, improve accessibility so everyone can enjoy the farm, expand our farm store, and provide the essential facilities our farmers and educators need to thrive.

Now let's grow the future.

The infrastructure that served us over twenty years ago is the same one we rely upon today.

Our main barn is over 240 years old and sustains our year-round farm stand operations.

Updates and renovations will:

- Improve shopping experience
- Introduce climate control
- Add a produce washing and bagging area to make farming operations more efficient
- Create an accessible entrance

Currently, we do not have a year-round indoor programming space to host educational programs or fundraising events during the changing seasons and inclement weather.

Improvements will

- Create a sustainably built indoor/outdoor accessible programming and event space with climate control
- Add a catering and demonstration kitchen, indoor restrooms, office space, and storage.

In addition to these enhancements, we will improve parking and traffic on the farm.
