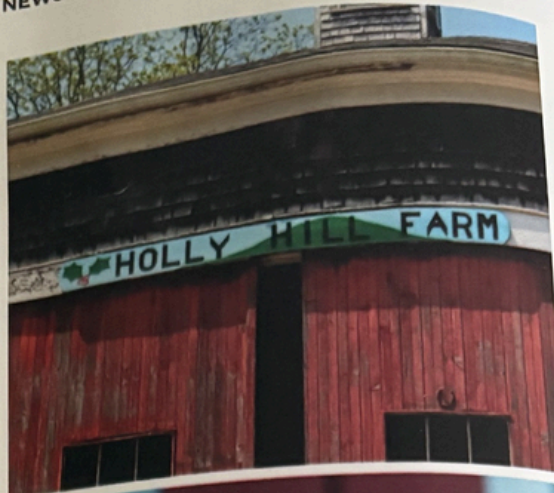

Keep Our Farm a Farm: Holly Hill To Host a May 2 Celebration on Cohasset Common

This spring, the beloved local nonprofit Friends of Holly Hill Farm (FHHF) is bringing the spirit of the farm to the heart of town.

On Saturday, May 2, 2026, from 11:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., the community

is invited to gather on Cohasset Common for *Keep Our Farm a Farm: Celebrating Our Farm. Growing Its Future* — a free, family-friendly event celebrating more than 20 years of growing, teaching, and serving the South Shore.

No tickets are required. Guests of all ages are encouraged to stop by anytime during the event to learn more about the farm's impact and its exciting plans for the future.

The afternoon will feature local food trucks including Del's Lemonade, Le Petite Pouf, Lolly Jolly Waffle Bar, Miss Emily's Food Truck, Mom on the Go, and South Shore Taco Guy, plus a 21+ beer garden hosted by Untold Brewing.

Live music from Mama Steph Music, Coldstart, and The Gratefuls will keep the Common lively, while hands-on workshop activities (available while supplies last) offer engaging fun for kids and adults alike.

"Our farm is more than the beautiful land where we grow healthy food to feed our neighbors; it is a place where curiosity, connection, and community flourish," said Meredith Laban, Executive Director of Friends of Holly Hill Farm. "Bringing a piece of the farm to Cohasset Common is our way of celebrating our farm with you and inviting everyone to help us grow what comes next."

Founded in 2002, Holly Hill Farm is the only working farm in Cohasset and has been continuously farmed since the early 17th century. Today, FHHF serves thousands annually through sustainable agriculture, food access initiatives, and educational programs that reach more than 20,000 students each year.
