Soup Cook-Off Official Rules

Rules and General Info:

- Meat/food items can be pre-cooked pre-chopped or can be cooked at the event. Soup must be assembled at South Shore Sportsman Club if you choose to prep prior to event. No canned soups can be used. The cooking area & methods should be as sanitary as possible.
- Contestants are responsible for furnishing their own cooking means. Propane stoves/ burners or crockpots must be set up outside and responsible for supplying all their own utensils and products including extension cords. No wood burning allowed. South Shore Sportsman Club will provide all entries with 1/2 of a picnic table and electricity if needed.
- All soup entries must achieve 165 degrees Fahrenheit and will be checked by South Shore Sportsman Club to verify prior to serving to attendees. Please plan enough soup for sampling - approximately 1.5-2 gallons=large crockpot.
- Setup starts at 12:00 pm and soup entries need to be ready by 3:45 pm. Sampling begins at 4:00pm. All contestants must have at least one person on hand throughout the event to serve and supervise their area until voting ends. Each contestant is responsible for cleaning up and for removing all items from their area. Cleaning may begin at 7:00pm and must be finished no later than 9:00pm.
- All entries are encouraged to be creative if you choose (Ex: team names, display, signs, costumes, themes)
- Judging will be done by “people’s choice” and will begin at 4:00 pm. Attendees, “the judges”, will be given one voting ballot for their favorite and a second ballot for pick of best presentation/showmanship upon entering the event. Ballots will be submitted in a container provided at the voting table.
- All ballots must be in by 6:45 pm, winners will be announced by 7:00 pm. Prizes will be given for Winner, 2nd place, 3rd place, & best presentation/showmanship.
- Sampling cups, bowls, plastic spoons, crackers, and napkins will be provided by the South Shore Sportsman Club .
- Drinks will be available to purchase from South Shore Sportsman Club bar at 12:00 pm.
- Entry Deadline for soup & corn hole is October 9th 2021 by 5:00pm. There is NO entry fee for soup.
