



* SSSC SCHOLARSHIP *

The South Shore Sportsman Club established this scholarship for the purpose of assisting outstanding high school graduates pursuing the field of conservation, wildlife management and/or related fields within these vocations.

APPLICANT CRITERIA

- Be a high school graduate or enrolled at any level of college in the required fields of study
- Become a full-time student enrolled for at least 12 credit hours per quarter or semester
- Scholarship may be renewed for up to four (4) years provided the recipient remains in good academic standing at the college or university of attendance
- Any applicant who is not selected to receive a scholarship may reapply the following year
- Applicants related to a South Shore Sportsman Club member will be given additional consideration

FUND MANAGEMENT

- Two \$500.00 Merit Scholarships will be available; however, it will be up to the Scholarship Committee as to how many will be awarded based on resources available and final approval of the South Shore Sportsman Club's members
- The South Shore Sportsman Club will grant one-half (1/2) of the funds for the following quarter/semester and the balance upon registration of the next quarter/semester
- The scholarship check will be made out to the recipient

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applicants must complete the South Shore Sportsman Club Scholarship Application official form
- Completed application must accompany the applicant's high school/college transcripts of the previous year/years, a short essay on applicant's vocation intention, a letter or recommendation on the applicant's academic and personal qualifications, a list of organizations/activities the applicant has participated in or held office/position within
- Application deadline is March 31st annually
- Applications will be screened by the South Shore Sportsman Club Scholarship Committee giving additional consideration to applicant related to SSSC members, and if deemed necessary all remaining qualified applications will be sent to an independent selection committee
- Upon notification to receive the scholarship award the recipients with parent/guardian will be expected to attend a presentation ceremony at the South Shore Sportsman Club

USE OF SCHOLARSHIP

- Scholarship awards may be used for tuition, fees, and books/supplies
