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### WELCOME TODDLERS

Welcome to the Toddler room! We are here to provide your two year old with a safe, "home like" environment where he/she can explore, create, play, and learn. We will do whatever we can to help your child feel loved and secure. Lots of hands-on learning activities that promote physical, social, emotional, spiritual, and cognitive development are provided daily.



Toddlers utilize both the Creative Curriculum and The Superbook Kids Bible App Curriculum by CBN in our weekly plans and

themes. The Bible App is a Christian Curriculum that bridges Biblical truths between school and home, in developmentally fun and appropriate ways, without pushing doctrines. The Superbook Kids Bible App for Kids may be downloaded and used as a family resource to support and extend each child's relationship with Christ, self and others.



This class is for children 24-36 months of age.

### TODDLERS DEVELOPMENT

#### Cognitive Development

Children this age continue to learn through play. Play begins to be more symbolic of real life. Time and numbers are still abstract for this age.

#### **Social Development**

Children begin to initiate play with each other and will play in small groups of 2 to 3 children. They also begin to imitate what they see.

#### Emotional Development

Children display feelings of anger, enjoy -ment, fear, and affection. They exhibit a strong desire for independence. Children begin to show empathy.

#### Fine Motor Development

During this year, the use of the hand, fingers, and thumb are refined. Precise fine motor skills are still hard to manage.

#### Gross Motor Development

Toddlers tend to walk with a wide stance. They can climb, push, pull, and hang with both hands. Children will use both arms and legs when only one is needed.

## WHAT TO BRING

- Crib sized sheet, blanket and a small pillow/stuffed animal (if desired) for naptime (in a reusable, zippered, non-plastic bag)
- Diapers or pull-ups, wipes, and ointment (if desired)
- Two sets of seasonally appropriate changes of clothing
- Seasonally appropriate outerwear for playing outdoors year round
- Sturdy shoes appropriate for active play (No flip flops please)
- Breakfast (if desired), and lunch (Both must be nut-free)
  RCELC supplies your child with a

PM snack and milk each day.
