"more beautiful for having been broken"



One of my prayer requests last month was for my friends Pastor Eddie & Rose English whose daughter had just died from cancer. When talking with them the day she passed I told them about the Japanese art of of "Kintsugi" which is the repairing broken pottery with gold. It literally means "more beautiful for having been broken" because once repaired it is actually sturdier and much more valuable than in its original form.

Similarly, I explained, when we get *broken* and allow God to mend us our faith is sturdier and we are more valuable in that we can now relate, and reach out, to others who may be going through a similar situation. (2 Corinthians 1:3-7)
