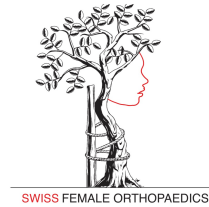

**AGA/SFO STArt Course Cooperation**  
**priority registration**

Attending the AGA STArt (SimulatorTrainingArthroskopie) course is a unique opportunity to gain arthroscopic knowledge and interact with local experts in the field.

The aim of the STArt Training is for participants to be able to move independently and safely with the arthroscope and instruments in the anatomical compartments of the knee and shoulder and to perform small, simulated procedures independently. During the intensive 2-day training, qualified instructors teach the theoretical basics and provide intensive coaching in the specific manual skills required for a professional arthroscopy.

Through the AGA/SFO STArt Course Cooperation, we are able to offer two female surgeons the opportunity to receive priority registration for these highly sought after and accredited educational events.
