

DAVIDSON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

Tuesday, February 10, 2026

The Davidson County Board of Elections met on Tuesday, February 10, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board of Elections office located at 945 N. Main Street, Suite A, Lexington, North Carolina 27292.

Chairman Freeman called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with the following members present: Secretary Belinda Clark, Richard Johnson, and Jason Cheek. Member Dan Francis was not present. Deputy Director Adam Moore and Election Administrative Manager Olivia Phillips were present. There were no visitors.

Secretary Clark read the minutes from the November 14, 2025 Board Meeting. Mr. Johnson made a motion to approve the minutes. It was unanimously approved.

Secretary Clark read the minutes from the February 3, 2026 Board Meeting. Mr. Cheek made a motion to approve the minutes. It was unanimously approved.

Deputy Director Adam Moore presented the board an Emergency Judge Appointment for the Democratic Judge at Precinct 30 – Dunbar. Secretary Clark made a motion to approve the emergency judge appointment. It was unanimously approved.

Deputy Director Moore presented the board with a list of At-Large Poll Observers submitted by the Davidson County Republican Party for the Early Voting period of the March 3, 2026 Primary Election. After review, Mr. Johnson made a motion to approve the list as presented. It was unanimously approved.

Deputy Director Moore presented the board with a Resolution to Delegate Authority to the Deputy Director for the March 3, 2026 Primary Election season. After review, Chairman Freeman made a motion to adopt the resolution as presented. It was unanimously approved.

Election Administrative Manager Phillips presented the board with 10 Civilian Absentee ballots recommended for approval. After review, Mr. Cheek made a motion to accept the 10 Civilian Absentee ballots.

Ms. Phillips presented the board with 1 Civilian Absentee ballot with the Photo ID Exception form recommended for approval. After review, Secretary Clark made a motion to accept the one ballot. It was unanimously approved.

Ms. Phillips presented the board with 2 Civilian Absentee ballots that were properly cured and recommended for approval. After review, Mr. Johnson made a motion to accept to the 2 ballots. It was unanimously approved.

Ms. Phillips presented the board with 1 Civilian Absentee ballot recommended to be not approved due to a witness deficiency. After review, Mr. Cheek made a motion to reject the 1 ballot. It was unanimously approved.

Once the ballots were tabulated, Secretary Clark made a motion to approve the cumulative tabulation of absentee ballots at 25. It was unanimously approved.

Deputy Director Moore gave the board an update on Early Voting preparations for the county, the Registration Repair Project, and voters who received a HAVA update letter in recent weeks.

Mr. Johnson made a motion to adjourn 6:43 p.m. and it was unanimously approved.
