

DAVIDSON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

Tuesday, April 23, 2024

The Davidson County Board of Elections met on Tuesday, April 23, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board of Elections office located at 945 N. Main Street, Suite A, Lexington, North Carolina 27292.

Chairman Cunningham called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with the following members present: Belinda Clark, Kathy Hunt, Richard Johnson, and Chad Freeman. Director Andrew Richards and Deputy Director Adam Moore were present. There were no visitors.

Secretary Clark read the minutes from the March 15, 2024 Board Meeting. Mr. Freeman made a motion to approve the minutes and was seconded by Mr. Johnson. It was unanimously approved.

Director Andrew Richards presented the board with 23 Civilian Absentee Ballots for the May 14, 2024 Second Primary recommended for approval. After review, Ms. Clark made a motion to approve the 23 Civilian Absentee Ballots and was seconded by Mr. Johnson. It was unanimously approved.

Director Andrew Richards presented the board with 4 Absentee Ballots that utilized the Photo ID Exception form and are recommended for approval. After review, Mr. Freeman made a motion to approve the 4 Absentee Ballots and was seconded by Mr. Johnson. It was unanimously approved.

Director Andrew Richards presented the board with 1 Overseas Ballot return packet and recommended approval. After review, Mr. Freeman made a motion to accept the 1 Overseas ballot return packet and was seconded by Ms. Hunt. It was unanimously approved.

Director Andrew Richards presented the board with the list of At-Large Observers for the May 14, 2024 Primary Election and Early Voting period submitted by the Davidson County Republican Party. After review, Mr. Freeman made a motion to approve the list of observers as submitted and was seconded by Ms. Clark. It was unanimously approved.

Director Andrew Richards reminded the board that the April 30, 2024 meeting would require all five board members to be presented since the Early Voting Schedule for the November 5, 2024 General Election will be on the agenda.

Mr. Freeman made a motion to adjourn at 6:26 p.m. and was seconded by Ms. Hunt. It was unanimously approved.
