

DAVIDSON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

May 17, 2022

The Davidson County Board of Elections met on Tuesday, May 17, 2022 at 2:00pm in the Board of Elections office at 945 N. Main Street, Suite A, Lexington, North Carolina 27292.

Ms. Clark called the meeting to order at 6:04pm with the following members present: Board Members Kathy Wall, Chad Freeman, and Richard Johnson. In the absence of Chairman Cunningham, the Board agreed to have Secretary Clark act as chair. Director Andrew Richards and Deputy Director Adam Moore were present along with one visitor.

The board agreed to postpone the reading and approval of the May 16, 2022 minutes until the next meeting.

Director Andrew Richards presented the Board with 1 Overseas Absentee Ballot Return packet that was returned for the May 17, 2022 Primary Election to be reviewed and approved by the board. After review, Mr. Freeman made a motion to accept the 1 Overseas Absentee Ballot Return packet and seconded by Mr. Johnson. It was unanimously approved.

Director Andrew Richards presented the Board with 10 Civilian Absentee Ballot Return Envelopes that were returned for the May 17, 2022 Primary Election to be reviewed and approved by the board. After review of the Absentee Ballot Return Envelopes, Ms. Wall made a motion to accept the 10 Absentee Ballots and seconded by Mr. Freeman. It was unanimously approved.

The board was presented with all of the Civilian, Overseas, and Military ballots that had been approved over the 2022 Primary Election season. The board conducted the tabulation of the approved ballots. One ballot, CIV-268, was not properly marked. Mr. Freeman made the motion to reject the ballot from CIV-268 and was seconded by Mr. Johnson. It was unanimously approved.

After tabulation, the board signed the results tapes in agreement of the results presented from the Absentee count.

Mr. Freeman made a motion at 3:31pm to adjourn the meeting and seconded by Mr. Johnson. It was unanimously approved.
