

DAVIDSON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

May 27, 2022 | CANVASS

The Davidson County Board of Elections met on Friday, May 27, 2022 at 11:00am in the Board of Elections office at 945 N. Main Street, Suite A, Lexington, North Carolina 27292.

Mr. Cunningham called the meeting to order at 11:06am with the following members present: Belinda Clark, Secretary and Board Members Kathy Wall, Richard Johnson, and Chad Freeman. Director Andrew Richards and Deputy Director Adam Moore were present along with one visitor.

Ms. Clark read the minutes from the May 26, 2022 board meeting. Ms. Wall made a motion to accept the minutes and seconded by Mr. Freeman. It was unanimously approved.


Director Andrew Richards presented the Board with the data from the 2022 Primary Election. There was a total of 21,235 votes cast overall in Davidson County. There were 39 Provisionals, 337 Absentees, and 8,965 One-Stop Early Voters. The remaining 11,894 votes were cast on Election Day.

Director Andrew Richards provided the Board with the Election Day balancing data. All precincts balanced after reconciliation except for two situations on Election Day. First, a Provisional ballot was tabulated in the DS200 tabulation machine in Precinct 38 – Eastside on Election Day. The Provisional voter was also a curbside voter and the poll workers tabulated the ballot by mistake. After further research, the voter's Provisional Ballot would have been fully accepted, thus the number of votes does not change by the error. Second, in Precinct 60 – Thomasville #1, a voter left the voting enclosure with their ExpressVote ballot, thus the ballot was not tabulated. Ms. Clark made a motion to accept the Election Day Balancing data as presented and was seconded by Ms. Wall. It was unanimously approved.

Five copies of the Abstract of Votes for Davidson County, North Carolina for Primary Election May 17, 2022 were provided to the Board. Each copy was reviewed by the members. Ms. Clark made a motion to accept the Canvass as presented on the Abstract of Votes report and was seconded by Mr. Johnson. It was unanimously approved. The five copies were signed by each member and notarized. The signed reports will be sent to the Davidson County Clerk, the City of Lexington, the NC State Board of Elections, and two copies for filing at the Davidson County Board of Elections.

Mr. Freeman made a motion to adjourn at 11:41am and seconded by Ms. Wall. It was unanimously approved.
