

DAVIDSON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

October 4, 2022

The Davidson County Board of Elections met on Tuesday, October 4, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board of Elections office located at 945 N. Main Street, Suite A, Lexington, North Carolina 27292.

Mr. Cunningham called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. with the following members present: Belinda Clark, Secretary, Board Members Kathy Hunt and Richard Johnson. Director Andrew Richards was present. One visitor was present.

Ms. Clark read the minutes from the September 14, 2022 board meeting. Mr. Johnson made a motion to accept the minutes and seconded by Ms. Hunt. It was unanimously approved.

Director Andrew Richards presented the Board with 229 Civilian Absentee Return Envelopes that were returned for the November 8, 2022 General Election to be reviewed and approved by the Board. After review, all 229 Civilian Absentee Ballots were approved.

Director Andrew Richards presented the Board with 1 Military Absentee Ballot Return packet that was returned for the November 8, 2022 General Election to be reviewed and approved by the board. After review, the 1 Military Absentee Ballots was approved.

Director Andrew Richards presented the Board with 1 Overseas Absentee Ballot Return packet that was returned for the November 8, 2022 General Election to be reviewed and approved by the Board. After review, the 1 Overseas Absentee Ballot was approved.

Director Andrew Richard also presented the Board with 9 Absentee Ballot Return Envelopes that did not meet the necessary requirements for approval. After review of the Absentee Ballot Return Envelopes, Ms. Clark made a motion to reject the 9 ballots and seconded by Mr. Johnson and it was unanimously approved. Director Richards told the board that Absentee cures have already been sent to those voters.

Director Andrew Richards asked the board if staff could open the approved Absentee Ballots from the October 4, 2022 Board Meeting to expediate tabulation at the next Board Meeting on October 11, 2022. Motion was made by Ms. Clark to allow staff to open the approved Absentee Ballots and seconded by Mr. Johnson and it was unanimously approved.

Ms. Clark made a motion to adjourn at 7:04 pm and seconded by Mr. Johnson. It was unanimously approved.
