Warranty Overview

Eurotex is committed to providing high-quality Heat Press machines and exceptional customer service. This warranty document outlines the coverage provided for Eurotex Heat Press machines. Please read this document carefully to understand your warranty coverage and your responsibilities.

1. Warranty Coverage

1.1 Mechanical Parts Warranty

Eurotex Heat Press machines are warranted against defects in materials and workmanship in mechanical parts for a period of **six (6) years** from the date of purchase. This includes all moving and non-moving mechanical components.

1.2 Electrical Components Warranty

Eurotex Heat Press machines are warranted against defects in materials and workmanship in electrical components for a period of **two (2) years** from the date of purchase. This includes all electronic boards, motors, control panels, and other electrical parts.

1.3 Labour Warranty

Eurotex Heat Press machines include a labour warranty covering repair and replacement services due to manufacturing defects for a period of **one (1) year** from the installation date.

2. Warranty Conditions

2.1 Validity

This warranty is valid only for the original purchaser of the Eurotex Heat Press machine and is not transferable. Proof of purchase must be presented when requesting warranty service.

2.2 Exclusions

This warranty does not cover:

- Normal wear and tear.
- Damage caused by misuse, abuse, neglect, or improper maintenance.
- Damage resulting from unauthorized modifications or repairs.

- Consumable items such as needles, bobbins, and threads.
- Damage caused by external factors such as accidents, natural disasters, or power surges.

3. Warranty Service

Labour costs for repairs conducted within the first year will be covered under the labour warranty. After the first year, the customer will be responsible for any labour costs.

4.1 Limitation of Liability

Eurotex' liability under this warranty is limited to the repair or replacement of defective parts as described above. Eurotex is not liable for any indirect, incidental, or consequential damages arising from the use or inability to use the embroidery machine.

This warranty is the exclusive warranty provided by Eurotex. No other warranties, express or implied, including warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, are provided.
