Member Spotlight



MEET Clyde Johnson

After retiring from the Federal Administration with over 30 years of service, Mr. Johnson served as the Director of Real Estate Services for the TBE Group for two years. He began his career in right-of-way Georgia Department Transportation in 1973. He served in the Office of Real Estate Services, Washington Office, from 1998 through 2002, and was responsible for FHWA's National Training Program and the Highway Beautification program; he also participated in the Uniform Act compliance and re-write. developed and presented the HI/FHWAN

Outdoor Advertising Control Workshop and presented the workshop in over 35 states. He assisted in the development of NHI's Appraisal, Appraisal Review Course for Federal Acquisitions. He has presented numerous NHI Courses covering the topics of Corridor Preservation and Sub-Surface Engineering. He served as the Realty Officer and Project Development Manager (Right-of-Way, Utilities and Environment in FHWA's Georgia Division Office from 1998 to 2002 and as the Realty Officer from 2002 until 2005. He served as Review Appraiser for the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for Region 6 during the vacancy of FTA's Real Estate Manager from 2003 and continues to do Administrative Review for FTA as of 2013. Mr. Clyde has been a member of the International Right of Way Association (IRWA)since 1978 and obtained his Senior Designation (SR/WA) in 1983. He has served as Chairman of the International Transportation Committee and as member-at-large on the International Relocation and Environmental Committees. He was appointed to the American Association of State Highway Transportation (AASHTO) Standing Technical Committee for Outdoor Advertising and was selected by the National Academy of Science to complete a national research study in Outdoor Advertising Sign Regulations in 2008. He has published numerous articles on transportation, environmental and outdoor advertising issues and received the IRWA Mark A. Green Scholarship Award in 1991 and 1994. In 1995, he received IRWA's highest award, the Frank C. Balfour "Professional of the Year" Award. In 2012 Mr. Johnson received IRWA'S first ever "Facilitator of the Year" award. In 2014, Mr. Johnson was presented IRWA's "Lifetime Achievement" Award for his dedication to the Association and the right-of-way field. Mr. Johnson is a CLIMB certified instructor for IRWA and has presented more than 28 different courses for IRWA since 1986.





INFRASTRUCTURE JUNKIES PODCAST




