The Brain Injury Alliance of Arizona is excited to partner with the Arizona Center for Disability Law (ACDL) for their first Virtual Voter Registration Drive for the 2020 General Election.

ACDL was recently named a recipient of the *Online Voter Registration Unique URL Pilot Program* from the Arizona Secretary of State's office. This Program ensures the voter registration drive can be conducted electronically and securely through the Secretary of State's website.

The main purpose of this non-partisan effort is to increase voter registration of Arizonans with disabilities. Your voice matters, and we want to make sure it is heard. Our goal is to register 1,000 voters by the General Election deadline, which is October 5, 2020.
