SpectrumRx: Neurodiversity Foundation Training for Pharmacy Practice

SpectrumRx Neurodiversity Foundation Training for Pharmacy Practice is a national program developed in collaboration between the Pharmaceutical Society of Australia and The Spectrum Pharmacist. This CPD-accredited, 10-module program offers two structured education pathways for pharmacists, interns, students and pharmacy assistants.

This program equips pharmacists and their teams, across all practice settings, with evidence-based, up-to-date foundational knowledge and the awareness that is the essential starting point for reducing stigma and delivering effective, person-centred care. With a strong focus on empathy, understanding, and practical application, the training builds confidence to support neurodivergent people, including those with autism spectrum disorder, attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder, intellectual developmental disability, communication disorders, motor disorders, and specific learning disorders.

Learners will apply tools and strategies from the training to real-world scenarios to provide respectful, individualised support that meets communication, sensory, and access needs.

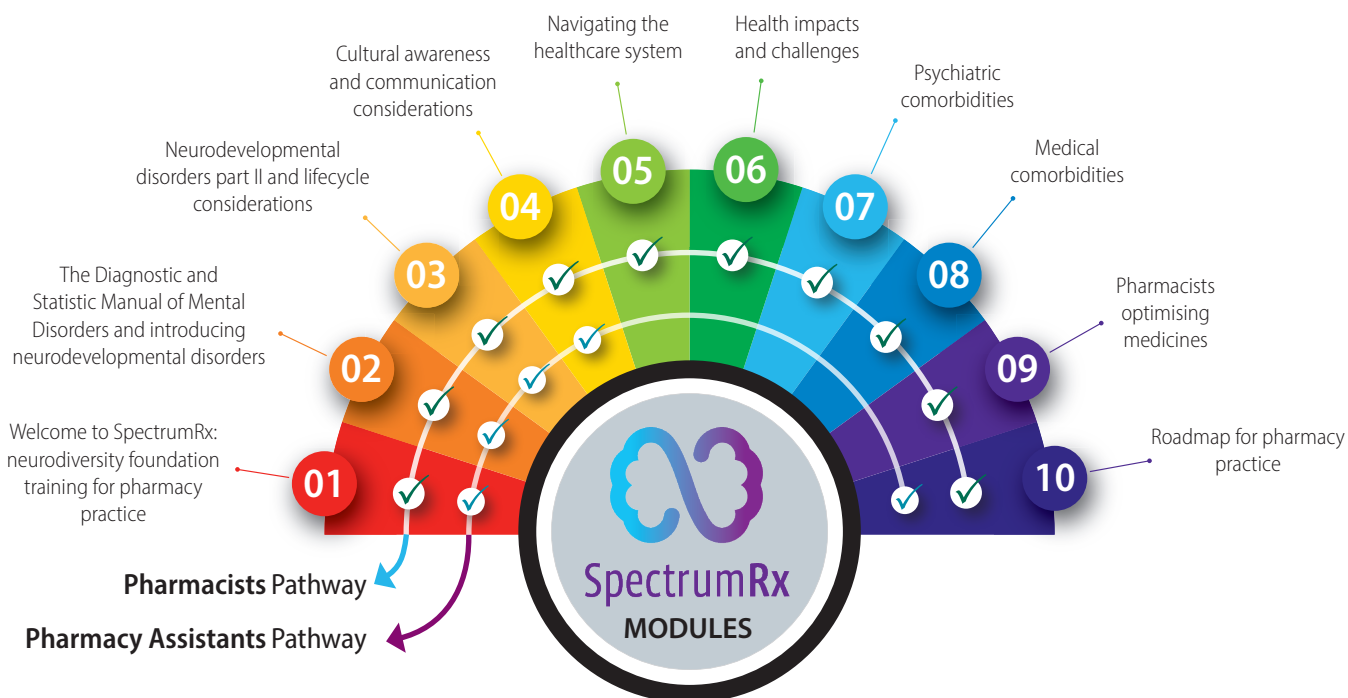
