

FIRE ANTS ... THEY'RE HERE AND LITERALLY A REAL BITE



HERE IS WHAT CAN BE DONE ABOUT IT.

“AMDRO” (1st & 2nd application). It is bait that eventually kills the Queen. “BENGAL ULTRADUST 2X” (third application). If a mound is destroyed, when one is cutting the grass . . . immediately sprinkle ULTRADUST. It can be carried in the mower drink holder. Usually, depending on the size of the mound, thousands come out at that time. WATCH ONE’S SHOES, preferably white, NO BARE FEET PLEASE!!! Stomping the ground will remove them while walking away. The DUST is a contact killer in about two hours. This means ants are spreading it around the hive, until they die. Gas or Raid etc. kills the grass, and the nest will shortly reappear a few feet over. This is because the egg laying QUEEN, who is as much as four feet down, is still alive.

ACE Hardware across from Hardees, and Byrum’s True Value Hardware in Edenton have both at a fair price, or other products that are just as good. If one is sowing their whole yard with a Fire Ant preventer, which may not be effective, buying the 5 lb bag is best from Walmart. Close neighbors can buy that as well and share it for savings. If per mound / nest treatment is done using the bottled containers of AMDRO or BENGAL, they should be kept in a cool dry place, but not the frig. It will cause condensation, ruining the product. Follow label instructions.
