- I. <u>Architecture Committee:</u> Mr. Baker reported there were 3 architectural warning letters sent out in the past month to property owners who did not go through the correct process in obtaining a permit before beginning work on their homes. Mr. Baker informed everyone that the architectural policy will be changing to charge \$100 if not obtaining a permit and \$25 per week until in compliance.
- J. <u>Communication Committee:</u> Mr. Taylor discussed more about the community watch and his correspondence with the Sheriff's Dept. and their support in us doing this.
- K. Community Affairs: Mr. Taylor reported there were 2 property transfers in Snug Harbor in July. Mr. Taylor informed everyone that the process to get Community Watch up and going is underway and he asked for volunteers for each section. Mr. Taylor also discussed the plan to make sure only property owners are using the boat ramps, which will be discussed further at the next meeting. Mr. Taylor reminded everyone that the next Adopt A Highway event will be on October 21st; Do Not Litter signs will be placed throughout the community. Mr. Taylor informed everyone that the board discussed the night fishing at the park and decided against it; the park will continue to be opened from dawn to dusk.
- L. <u>Civic League:</u> Mr. Taylor informed everyone of the Ice Cream Social today sponsored by Civic League and Snug Harbor Church. Mr. Taylor reminded everyone of the Luau next week which is a BYOB event; our insurance approves this as long as we do not provide any mixers and only beer and wine that is 15% alcohol or less is allowed.
