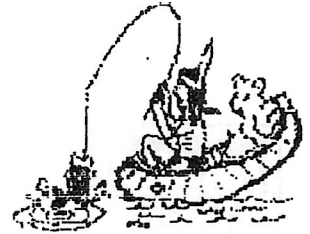

Pool Opening

Pool opening day is set for Saturday, May 25 at 1:00p.m. and it will be open weekends only until Tuesday, June 11, when school is scheduled to end. Adult swims are scheduled for 10 to Noon Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, and Wednesdays from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m.

Each person entering the pool will be required to wear a disc on ankle or wrist. Discs can be obtained at the office by property owners or renters whose 1991 assessments are up to date. Cost is \$1.00. All are asked to please sign in the recording book each time they enter the pool area.

Detailed pool regulations will be provided along with the discs. These rules are designed to ensure that your use of the pool will be a safe and enjoyable experience. Basic rules are:

- No Running - No Glass Containers - No Suntan Oil, Lotion is OK - No Food in pool area, except for approved party. - No Inflatable Toys - No Alcoholic Drinks - No Bouncing on the Diving Board.

The pool operator's word is the Law. The pool operator is not employed as a lifeguard. Pool users are responsible for their own safety and parents are responsible for safety of their children. Connie Hanchuck has been employed to be the pool operator, so please welcome her and give her your cooperation.

Civic League News

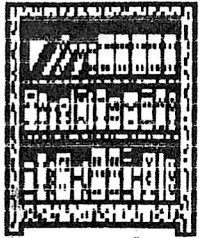

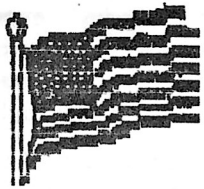

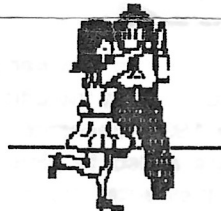

Vice Pres. - Richard Kaiser

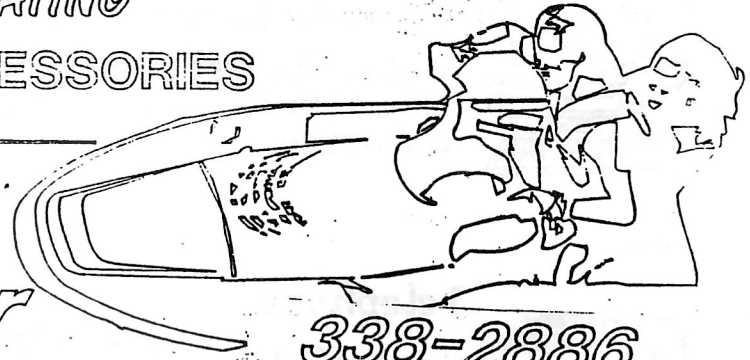
Treasurer - Kathleen Selleck; Sec. - Retta Brack
