Homeowners Associations (HOA) are typically charged with maintaining common areas, managing community finances, and enforcing Covenants, By- Laws and Board Policies.

There are many stories to be told about HOA's that have written in their governing documents restricting such things as the color of their homes, where the mailbox has to be placed, where to place a lamp post, driveway or sidewalk and where you plant your flower garden. Some will outlaw the number of cars or pick-up trucks per driveway. Yes, we have Covenants, By-Laws, rules and regulations. Yes, we have yearly Assessments and, yes, we have a Board of Governors that works hard to make sure community finances, community properties and community rules and regulations are up to date and well managed. Our rules and regulations are very simple and non-restrictive. They are written to benefit property values and to keep the community well maintained. Aesthetic reminder:

our covenants, although not very restrictive have a few items we would like to remind our owners of.

Section 3. Aesthetic Control. All Lots.

"In the event that the condition or appearance of any building, mobile home, camping facility, recreation vehicle, trailer, boat or any other article of real or personal property located on any Lot is such that, in the judgment of the Board of Governors of the Association adversely affects the property values, health or safety of persons in the subdivision, the owner shall, upon written request by said Board of Governors, remove or repair the property within 60 days of written notice"

"No nuisance of offensive, noisy or illegal activity shall be done, suffered, or permitted upon any Lot or the Common Area and no part of any Lot or Common Area shall be used or occupied to affect injuriously the use or value of other Lots or of the subdivision. Outside trash and garbage shall be maintained in sturdy containers, as inconspicuously as practical, and they shall be emptied regularly. No animals, livestock or poultry of any kind; other than customary household pets, shall be kept or maintained on any Lot. No junk, wreck, or inoperative automobile, truck, trailer or boat shall be permitted to remain on the property, nor shall other unsightly materials be stored

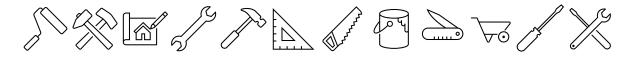

#### Prostate cancer screening

#### Eligibility criteria

- Starting at age 40-45 for all Black men, regardless of risk factors
- · Starting at age 40-45 for all men who are high risk
- Starting at age 50 for all men of average risk
- No prostate screening within the past 12 months
- · Not actively being treated for prostate cancer
- No symptoms

Colorectal cancer screening FIT kits will be available for no-cost mail-in testing. Please don't miss your opportunity to receive these lifesaving early detection screenings.

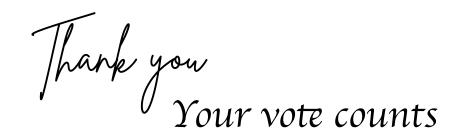

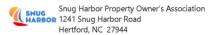

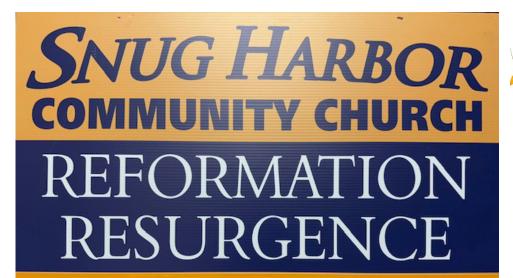
