The only goal of the POC Toy Run is to collect and deliver new Christmas toys to the Angel Tree program in Port O'Connor, Texas. The Angel Tree, in-turn, manages distribution of the toys to needy children all along the Texas Gulf Coast region. Just some of the recipients include at-risk youth centers, orphanages, foster homes, brown santa, blue santa and individual families caught in hard times. We do not, and never will, see any of the children we assist. The gifts they receive are from Santa. We also do not have sponsors...only donors, and 100% of the funds we raise goes to the children. We have no payroll.
