
A lot of excitement and momentum is building to make this a record event. The advertising for this event has already started in National motorcycle magazines, and the web.

Food Vendors offering hot or cold prepared foods –

Such as (but not limited to) hot dogs, burgers, chicken, sausage, steak, gyros, kettle corn, popcorn, pizza, fried dough, roasted nuts, ice cream, sno cones, slush drinks, fruit salads, etc

FEE per 20 x 10 \$675

Refundable Cleaning Deposit \$200

Each foot over 20' is \$10 per foot

Electrical Power

Please indicate your power needs on the application. Power will be provided by Gears-N-Grub. Absolutely NO generators are permitted. Please bring any cord covers if needed. At least 100' electric cord is suggested

Insurance

You must carry and provide proof of comprehensive general liability insurance with coverage not less than \$1,000,000 single limit, active during the term of the event. If accepted, you will need to submit a certificate of insurance indemnifying and holding harmless Gears-N-Grub and Wattsburg Agricultural Society Erie County Fair, and their agents, officers, and employees from all claims from damage to property or bodily injury, including but not limited to death, which may arise out of any permission issued herewith. Gears-N-Grub and Wattsburg Agricultural Society Erie County Fair must be named as additional insured. This policy shall not be terminated or canceled prior to July 19, 2020

Permits

The right to operate a concession in Erie, PA is contingent upon the approval of County Health Department. Please indicate if you have an annual or need a temporary Food License issued through the County Health Department. It is your responsibility to contact the Erie County Health Department prior to the event and pay any applicable fees for said license.

Upon Acceptance, you will be required to submit by May 1, 2020:

- Copy of your certificate of insurance
- Booth fee paid in full
- Separate check in the amount of \$200 for cleaning deposit (will not be cashed unless violations of rules)

Food Vendor Rules

Gears-N-Grub is growing. For that reason we will hold food vendors to very high standards to represent our event.

The following rules and regulations apply to ALL food vendors:

1. Event hours are 11 am to 10 pm Friday and Saturday and 11 am to 7 pm Sunday. Vendors **MUST** be open and READY TO SERVE during festival hours. Absolutely no early tear down. If violated, you will not be permitted to apply in the future and your deposit will be forfeited.
2. Vendors that are using tents must place tar paper on the floor of your booth and sidewalk areas at all times to keep grease and food from the pavement. Failure to place the tar paper on the booth space will result in automatic forfeiture of your cleaning deposit.
3. Cardboard boxes must be broken down and placed in front of your booth at the end of each night.
4. Vendors must bring their own trash cans. Trash cans in the event area are not for vendors' use.
5. Vendors must comply with all Erie County Health Department regulations.
6. You are responsible for keeping your area clean and sanitary at all times. Any trash that needs to be disposed of throughout the day can be placed behind your concession. We will have people collecting trash throughout the day.
7. Acceptance to participate this year does not guarantee acceptance in subsequent years.
8. Vendor spaces cannot be reserved. Placement is not guaranteed from one year to the next, and are subject to change.
9. We are working on securing a beverage company for sponsorship. You must only sell the sponsoring company's product, which must be purchased at the event. All vendors will sell bottled water for \$2.00 and all other bottled beverages for \$3.00.
10. The \$200 deposit must be in the form of a check made out to Gears-N-Grub. This check will **NOT** be cashed unless your area is left dirty, grease, or other rules not followed. The check will be returned within one week of the close of festival.
11. No subletting of space.

Failure to comply with the regulations outlined above could result in the forfeiture of your cleaning deposit, or the right to participate in future years.
