Holden Family Scholarship: Pursuing Allied Health program of study

1. Graduating from Sabine Parish high school in 2024.
2. Minimum 2.5 GPA (unofficial transcript or grade report required).
3. Planning to enroll full-time in an associate or bachelor's degree program at an accredited higher education institution.

The scholarship is designed for a graduating Sabine Parish high school student who demonstrates their desire and ability to overcome barriers and to achieve their goals. In addition to the above criteria, selection to be evaluated based on:

1. Individual determination to succeed.
2. Future goals and plan to achieve them.
3. Ability to communicate the challenges you have overcome or currently experience to continue your education.
4. Self-motivation in completing challenging course work.
5. Demonstrated need for financial assistance.

Scholarship funds will be forwarded directly to the college or university. No individual or personal distribution of funds.
