



- **Clinical information:** Solitary nodule, 71/M left lower gluteus
- **DIAGNOSIS:**
 - SKIN, LEFT LOWER GLUTEUS, EXCISION: TRICHOADENOMA
- **Teaching Points:**
 - On face, sometimes buttocks
 - Benign adnexal neoplasm
 - Resembles infundibula of hair follicle
 - No margin status or further therapy needed
- **Minimal Diagnostic Criteria:**
 - Collection of well-circumscribed small cysts
 - No infiltration of surrounding stroma
 - Cyst lining resembles keratinization of epidermis
 - Fibrotic stroma in between cysts
- **Differential Diagnosis:**
 - Trichofolliculoma
 - Nevus comedonicus
 - Syringoma
