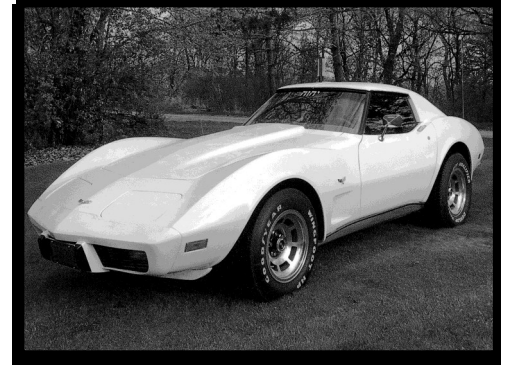

Club Cars free - 25	Model Cars - 100

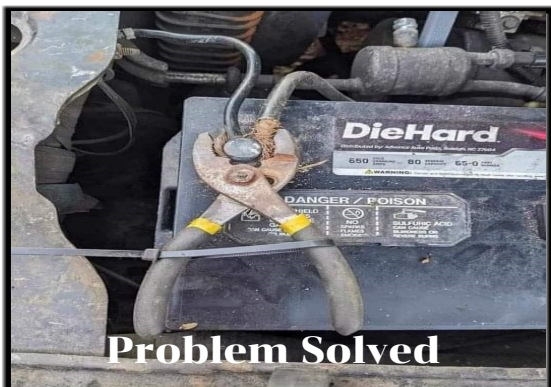
Total show cars - 527 Fun Run - 160 (up from last year)
