

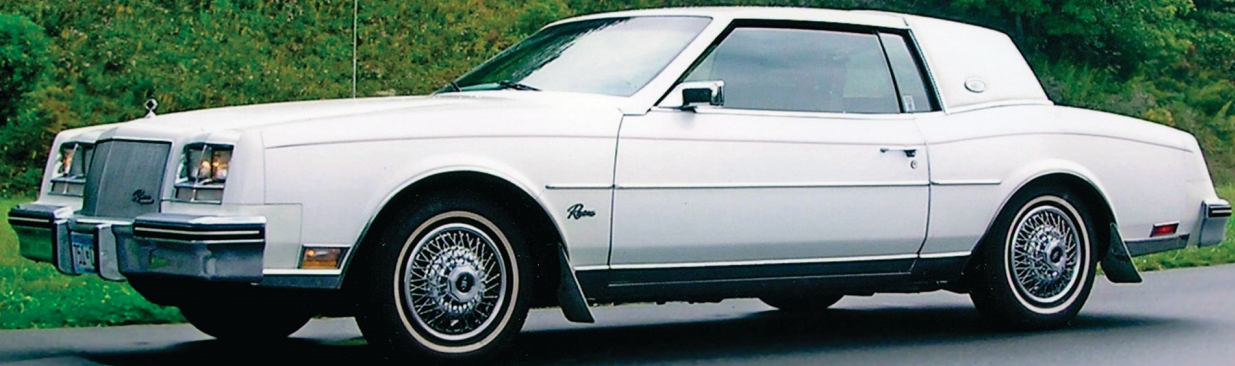

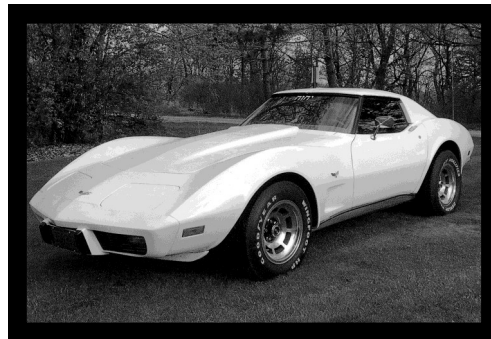


## President's Report

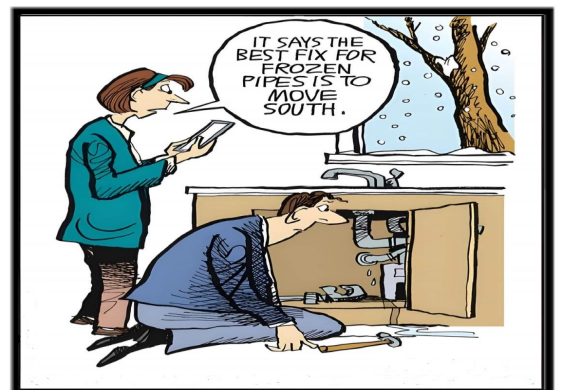
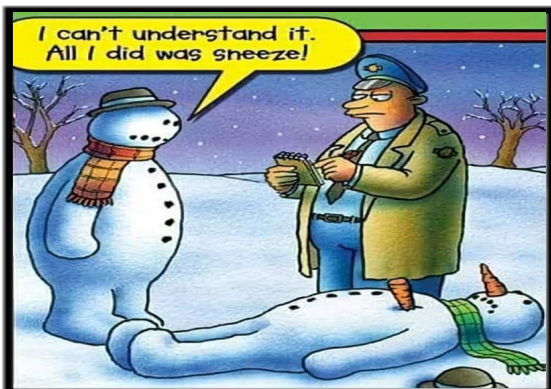

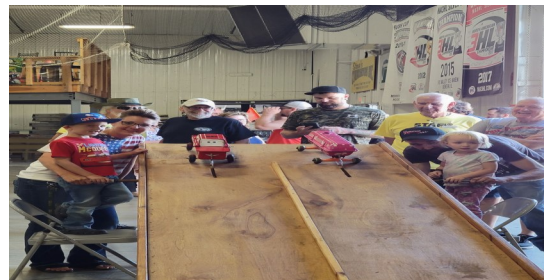
