Car Show Chairman Report

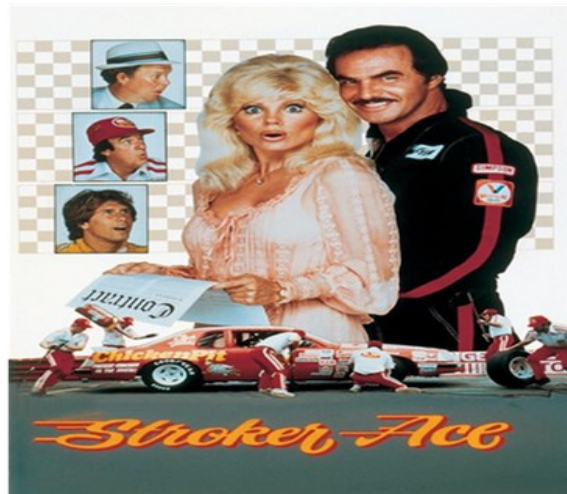

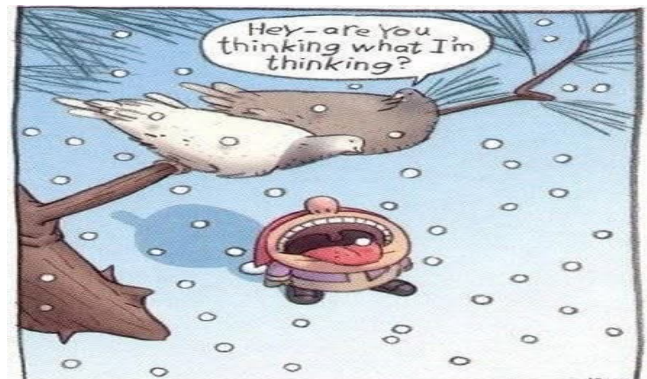
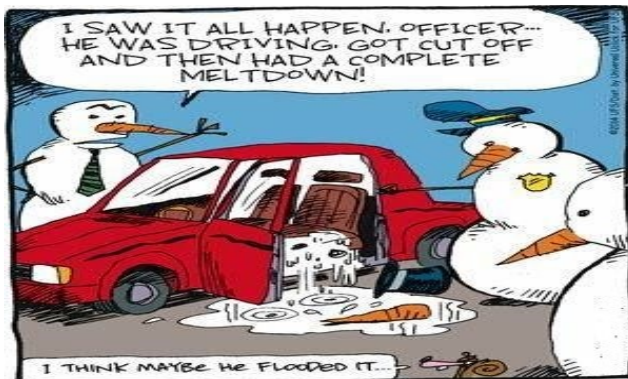
