

Clean Thoroughly

Wash and wax the exterior to protect the finish from moisture and contaminants. Clean the interior to remove all food and other items that could attract pests.

Change Fluids:

Get an oil and filter change, as old oil contains corrosive byproducts that can damage the engine while sitting.

Fill The Gas Tank:

Fill the fuel tank completely to prevent moisture buildup and corrosion. Add a fuel stabilizer to protect the fuel system.

Check All Fluids

Top off all other fluids like coolant and transmission fluid if necessary.
