OTHER THEN THE PREVIOUS OWNER DOING SOME RATTLE CAN PAINTING THAT KIND OF MATCHED IN AN ATTEMPT TO COVER UP SCRATCHES IN THE ORIGINAL PAINT. IT ALSO WAS IN NEED OF MECHANICAL REPAIRS THAT I DID MYSELF. I DROVE THE MUSTANG SUMMERS AND DROVE OTHER BEATER CARS DURING THE WINTERS. 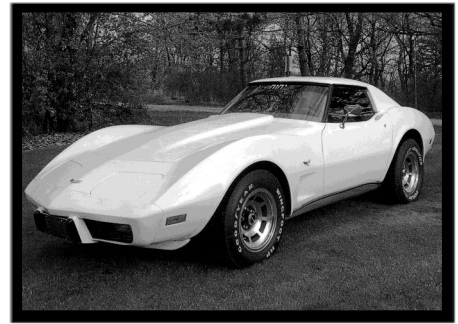

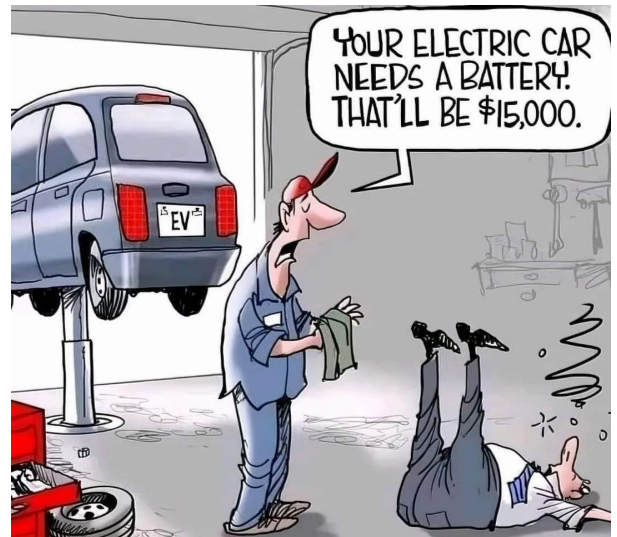

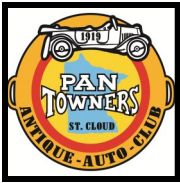
