

Car Of The **MONTH**

1948 Ford Anglia British
Owner: Dan Brady



The Ford Anglia was a British car from Ford in the UK. It was related to the Ford Perfect and later the Ford Popular. The Ford Anglia name was applied to four models of car between 1939 and 1967. 1,594,468 Anglias were produced, before it was replaced by the new Ford Escort.

An Anglia tested by the British magazine, The Motor in 1948 had a top speed of 57 mph and could accelerate from 9-50 mph in 38.3 seconds.

We all have certain cars that we wanted to own and drive, the Ford Anglia was one of those on my list. I came across this car for sale in Facebook/Market place. I emailed the seller and remarked that I really liked the car but felt it was a little out of my price range. I received a reply and he asked if I had anything that I might trade. At this time I owned a 1972 Plymouth Duster and sent him a number of pictures of the Duster. He replied that he was very interested in trading but I would have to come up with additional money beside the Duster. We agreed on the final trade. The car was in Spokane Washington and he suggested that he could send a enclosed trailer containing the Anglia and in turn I would send the Duster back in the same trailer.

The car arrived and it was as advertised. The car had at one time been a drag car. It has a built 355 ci csb, 700R transmission, narrowed 9in. Rear with 31 in Hoosier tires. Some of the roll cage over the doors had been removed. Needless to say the car is a blast to drive. Like many of you I get behind the wheel and I go from 79 to 18 again. I have a few minor issues with the car but these currently are being tended to. Thanks for voting my car to be in the 2024 calendar. Dan Brady





3rd Year: Kevin Sanders and Dan Arntson had nothing.


Pan Committee: Green Pan Car is ready to go to more events. August 1st the Pan Car will be at Miller Auto Plaza until our car show.


