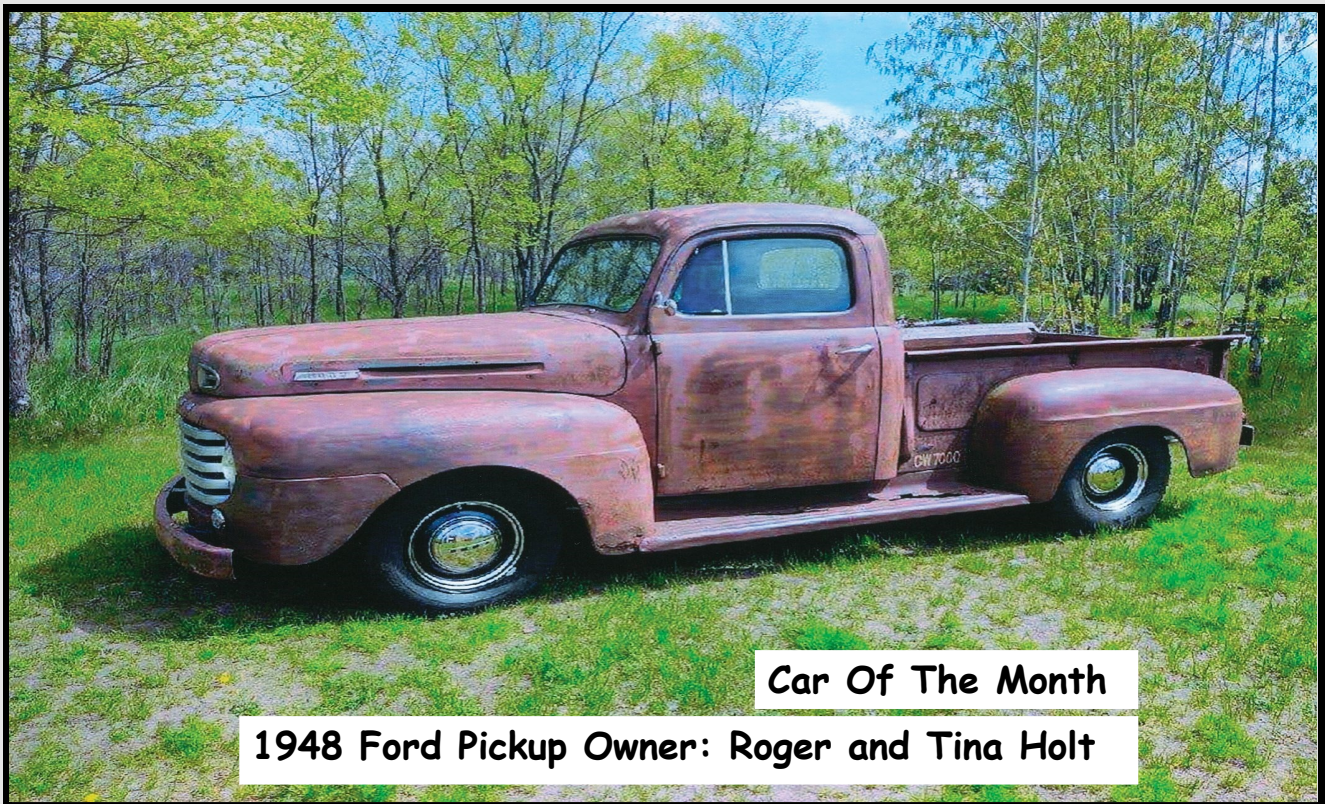

President's Report

This is the big month! The car show is here. You will have one last chance to volunteer at the August general meeting, on the 10th, at the Benton County Fairgrounds. Some of the chairs still need help on Friday, Saturday and Sunday and don't forget Monday, clean-up day. I have started a trail run on the award's point system. You will find a copy in the special email you got or will be getting with the by-laws, standing orders, job descriptions, participation award program and a reworded mission statement. The By-Law Revision Committee presented its revisions to the board on Thursday, the 20th. The board rejected the dues increase and other language which was removed and then recommended to be presented to the general membership. Our main goals were to increase member involvement, reward working members, and equalize the work load on officers and the board and allow the car show chairman and officers and earlier start on duties (i.e. rosters and car show); create a balanced budget that is more in line with our 501C-3 non-profit status. I encourage you to review the by-law changes and to keep these goals in mind. To help guide you through the reviewing process, I have listed the major sections that have been changed to meet the goals we have set forth. The revision will be sent to you via email and put on the website for you to see. If you don't have computer access please call me and I will mail a copy to you. Note: red letters are new language and yellow over-lays are deleted language. Major areas of revision for the By-Laws are as follow: Article II Membership, section 1-C, life memberships are discontinued after 2024. I-D has been added to define a "member in good standing". Section 4 clarifies rosters and calendars provided. Section 7 clarifies new member pro-rated dues. Article IV Section 4 clarifies board vacancies. Article V Section 3 clarifies voting and balloting. Section 5 is the proposal for new terms of officers. Major area of revision for the Standing Orders are as follow: Section 1 redefines the job descriptions under the Officers new terms listed in the by-laws. Section VI changes the names of the banquets and set up a cost structure to help budgets for the events. Section VII Car show: new language to define worker award point system. Section VII Library book committee clarifying responsibilities. Section IX Historian; new job description. A vote on by-law changes will be held at the October general meeting and if passed will take effect in October, 2023. Many thanks to the committee who has put in much time and effort into this endeavor and we will look forward to your comments.

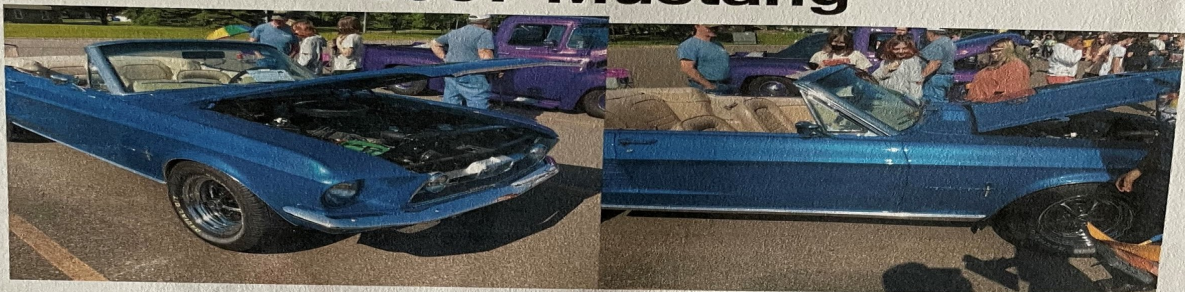

Car Show Chairman Report

Hi Everyone, As I write this, we have a little over 26 days to our show. I'm working on some final reviews and verification that everything is in order and we will be good to go. We had a meeting for the show chairs on July 19th and things seemed pretty well in order. A big concern was the construction on the east side, and Betty is posting a statement/warning on our website about it. We are stating to refer to your GPS for a route to the fairgrounds, and that coming on Benton Drive and turning down 2nd ave. south is an option. Ralph Anderson has agreed to work with Paul Schmidbauer on our gate admissions, so I'm confident we will have that area covered and I thank Ralph for his help! The Next X car club is completely on board with helping run the new Laid-Back Class, for directing cars to the correct area and getting them registered and parked. They are excited to help us with the show and are a resource we can continue to tap into for the future. Bernick's is donating 17 cases of pop and 8 cases of water to our show, so that will be a big help in our kitchen area. Also in the kitchen area, we will have water and coffee available for the show workers in the back corner as we have done in years past. I did a quick review with Rick at the fairgrounds regarding our parking and one of the changes this year will be swapping the location of the 4 door & wagon class, with our club cars, to give more room for the larger 4 doors and wagons. Please see the separate notice for registering your collector car if you are bringing it to the show. For those workers driving their regular cars, we ask that you park in the north lot, especially if you are planning on staying for all or most of the day. Also please remember to wear your yellow staff shirt if you are working and also all members must wear your badge at the show. I have admission passes, pop or water tickets and meal tickets (good for one breakfast in the kitchen or one lunch in the kitchen or one brat - only one not all). Thanks to Dijital Majik for providing all of the tickets this year with no cost to the club - a great donation - be sure and thank Don Blonigen when you see him!! Also, regarding donations, Andy Mohs at Miller Buick GMC will be covering the cost of radio promotions for our show starting the first of August and increasing to 50% of their on-air time for our show by mid-August. Another great expense - I had quotes from about \$800 up to over \$3,000 for a week of radio advertising - again make sure you thank Andy if you see him! We will be doing a radio interview with Kelly Cordes on WJON on August 15 from 11:15 to 11:30 AM, be sure to listen in. We have ads for our show in a couple of local magazines, and am working on getting an ad out on Facebook and social media. I will have the 2023 clothing for sale at our Pan Car appearances at the shows in Cold Spring and Celebrate Minnesota, this will also be a promotion for our show and club. Please see the separate notice for the clothing and contact me with any order requests. Of course, the clothing will also be on sale at our August general meeting. We will be filling our goodie bags on Wednesday August 16th 6:30 P.M. at Tim Carlson's warehouse. Please come if you are able to help. Finally, Jim Zwilling is recovering from surgery and Wendy Theisen is dealing with health issues at this time so I ask that you pray for God to give them some comfort and strength and to provide His healing. **Also, keep praying for nice weather the 3rd weekend in August**

PROPOSAL TO INCREASE MEMBERSHIP PARTICIPATION IN CLUB SPONSORED EVENTS

ISSUE:

There is a desire to get more club membership involved in events that help to fulfil the club's mission statement, which is: "To preserve the history of the Pan Motor Company and the Pan automobile: Educate current and future generations about the collector car hobby and the role the automobile has played in society: Promote the transfer of knowledge and skills to the next generation by investing time, talent and capital in future club projects and functions".

BACKGROUND:

Currently, the club fulfills a majority of our mission to the public by the following events:

- 1) Member (with collector car) participation in parades
- 2) Member (with collector car) participation in nursing home displays
- 3) Member (with collector car) participation in spring and fall tours
- 4) Pan Car display at various events to include car shows, parades, and other venues asked for by the public.
- 5) Our Car Show
- 6) Other area Car Shows

Currently, our involvement for parades is extremely low based on many factors (including time of day, cars overheating, etc.). Involvement with nursing homes may be considered adequate for some but not all events. Pan Car displays are few, whereas more participation would be beneficial. Spring and Fall Tours and parties have fared the best of these events.

GOAL:

To increase membership involvement in all, club events.

RECOMMENDATION:

To provide AWARDS as a way to increase members' interest and involvement, by establishing a point system.

PROPOSAL:

The club could provide AWARDS at the annual Presidents Awards Banquet in November each year and the Car Show Awards banquet in March. The award would be based upon member involvement in club events for that calendar year, October 1-September 31. Awards would be given to the top individuals, in each category, with the highest participation based upon a point system. The Sgt. at Arms would record the points from event chairpersons.

ADDITIONAL THOUGHTS

- 1) Each event coordinator/ Chairpersons would turn in the list of workers/participants to the Sgt. of Arms.
- 2) Banquets and tour fee discounts would be based on participation points earned.
- 3) Banquet/tours guests, non-participating or non-worker members will be charged full price.

CAR EVENT AWARD POINTS SYSTEM (tentative)

1. A point would be given to each collector car at an event (not a point for each person - example: husband/wife with vehicle gets 2 point. Single person with vehicle gets 2 point).
2. The navigator or passengers would each get 1 point towards the club award system.
3. Participation in nursing home displays: 2 point each.
4. Participation in parades: 4 points.
5. Participation in each club Spring and Fall tours. 2 point for each.
6. Enter collector car in OUR show, 2 point

CLUB AWARDS SYSTEM (tentative)

Points awarded on an individual basis

- 1) Monthly club meetings: 1 point, members must check in to receive the point
- 2) Officers of the club: 5 points
- 3) Car show departments chair: 5 points
- 4) Car show shifts: 1 point per 2 hour shift / max of 4 points per day
- 5) Special committees/ volunteer workers: 2 point, Example: ditch clean-up, Pan Car committee, nomination committee, etc.
- 6) Free admission to our car show for all works (Fri, Sat., Sun., or Mon.) A special pass will be issued to each worker. Club name badge must be worn. Other members must pay full price at the gate.
- 7) Free admission for all club members pre-registering their collector car in the show
- 8) Participation in Pan Car events: transporting or promoting the club (Pan Car) at the event. 2 points.
- 10) Bring in a new member, 2 points per new member

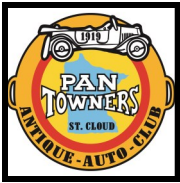
