One last note - I got voted out of office last month so now I have No official title. Yess!




ANNOUCEMENTS: Thank you card from Cheryl Voigt and Helen Coberg

SECRETARY: Tina Holt mentioned calling people that have not paid their membership dues yet and the need for pictures of the new board members.


