Hi Everyone, The car show is getting closer, as I write this, we have 2 months to go. For up-dates this month, Bullet Bob did contact me and will be our D J for the show again this year. As far as show promotions, our old budget had very little earmarked for that, so I'm working with Andy Mohs at Miller Buick, GMC, and he will be helping cover some of our show promotions. Last year he did some radio promotions, and this year he will do that again as well as some internet promotions. This is an additional show expense he is sharing and also helping expand awareness of our show on the internet. If you get a chance, swing by Miller and talk to Andy, say you are a member of our club and personally thank everything he is helping us with this year! Andy is glad to be a part of our show! I have been seeking donations for our show in the form, of goodie bag items, door prizes or cash contributions and at this point have seven organizations contributing. I do have an additional 23 requests to various places, so am hoping we will have our returning supporters and possibly a few new ones this year. We are also following the guidelines for contributions to 501 C-3 organizations this year so all contributions with values of \$250 or more will receive a receipt from us to be used for their taxes. We are distributing flyers at car shows, so if you are going to a show, please make sure you take some flyers with you to help distribute them. Speaking of flyers, Angie at MCSI said the flyers printed for us at no cost this year would have been a \$1,000 expenditure for us. If you need copy equipment, or know someone that does, please have them check out MCSI and say the Pantowners recommended them. Believe it or not, as I write this the 2023 shirts are still in process, and I have started taking orders for them. This year we will have T shirts in 3 colors at \$12 each, sweat shirts in 2 colors at \$30 each, hooded zipper front sweat shirts in blue at \$35 each and caps at \$10 each. July 19th. at the Moose to review any last-minute things that will need to be done with one month to go before the show.


