




I began the frame off restoration in March of 2019 after we had retired and moved to Avon MN. The car then went to the body shop in November of 2019 and I got the car back from the body shop in March of 2021. The body and paint work was done by Avon Auto Repair and Body Shop. it turned out awesome. It took me until October of 2022 to get it all together and take it on its first test drive. Its first outings were the parade on Spunk Days in Avon, Cold Springs car show, and the Benton County Fair all in 2023. 
Vice President's Report
