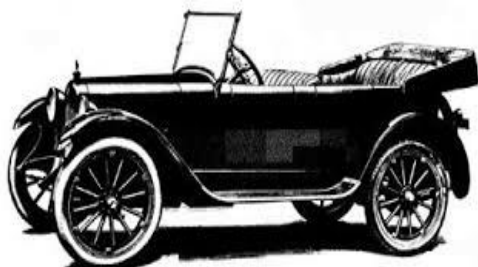

### Letter From Joe Tetrault

Joe Tetrault sent Bob Salmonson a note and the board thought it would be a good idea to share with the members. Rewrite by Lily Prince.

In regard to fees, Joe says, we need to check with RBC about closing costs. With Edward Jones, the account Joe would open has no annual fees and Joe is not charging a management fee. If we called Joe and asked him to liquidate \$5000 and send it to the operations account, the sale would cost approx. \$113.62, that includes a 15% discount Joe gives to clients on the buy/sell of a stock. Joe makes roughly \$45.45, and Edward Jones keeps the rest for branch and home office expenses. If we later repay that \$5000 back to the account, Joe can't reinvest back into the same fund we currently own. Joe would make a purchase recommendation on a new investment, explain the costs, and then wait for us to approve the purchase. Joe will supply a "Summary of Costs Paid" report that can be shared with everyone. This summary will list every dollar that Edward Jones has made on our assets for that year. To the best of Joes Knowledge Edward Jones is the only firm that has such a report. Ideally, Joe's goal would be to build up our account further. Have certain investments that we "avoid selling" because they produce greater income. Then use short term investments that are less costly and more liquid for the funds needed. Joe say's to be honest helping with this account is not a big money maker for him or Edward Jones The reasons Joe wants to help are:

1. Joe was referred to the group and that's a big complement and Joe appreciates the confidence.
2. By attending meeting, answering questions, and showing a genuine interest in club events, he hopes over time it will open the doors for other members on the personal side.
3. Joe is hopeful that through account growth, the club will see value in the relationship and expand it's investments within the account. Joe hopes this is helpful in answering questions and looks forward to hearing from us. Joe also thanked us for this opportunity.

## Car Show Chairman Report

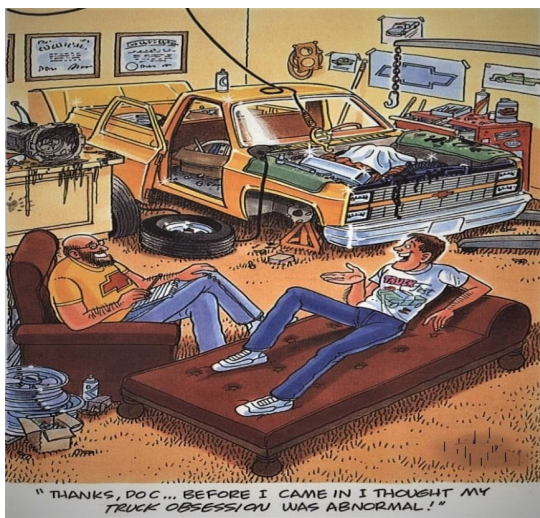

**Old Business:** Container upkeep after car show. To be discussed at general meeting next.

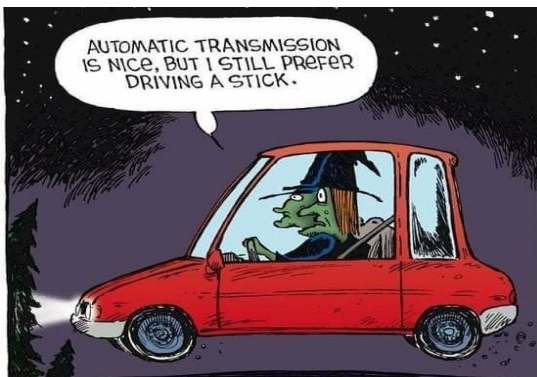
**New Business:** Congratulations! We won a trophy for most members in attendance at Little Falls Car Show. Mailing thank you cards.

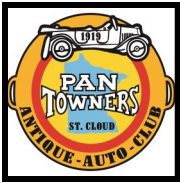
