\*Caregiver must be present for testing or have signed release on-file

## *Who should have a hearing assessment and how often?*

(Oklahoma DOH, 2012)

### *Minimum Recommendation*

- ◆ Annual screening for students 3 years old through 3rd grade
- ◆ Grades 6, 9, and 12 recommended
- ◆ Initial enrollment in a Special Education program (consider annual monitoring)
- ◆ New referral for speech and language or psycho-educational evaluation
- ◆ New student transfer without record of hearing screening

### *Additional Considerations*

- ◆ Students with a diagnosis often associated with hearing and/or auditory processing concerns: cleft lip and/or palate, Down syndrome, ADD/ADHD, Autism Spectrum Disorder, etc.
- ◆ Teacher and/or caregiver concern for inattention or difficulty following oral instruction in the classroom
- ◆ Students repeating a grade
- ◆ Students with chronic ear infections or congestion
