Testing can be done almost anywhere!

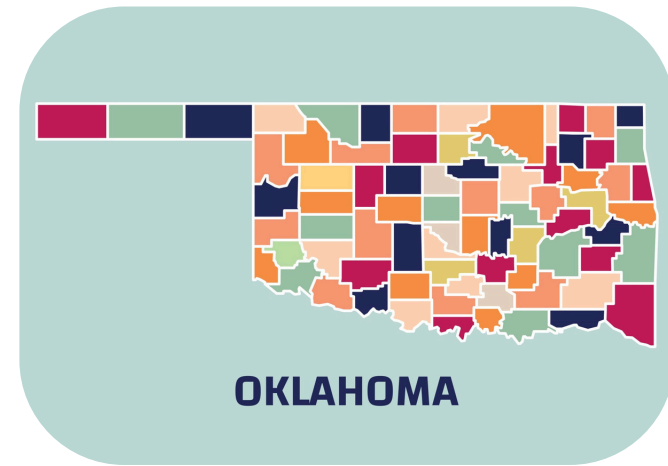
*Caregiver must be present for testing.

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Newborn Hearing Screening Facts

(Oklahoma DOH, 2022)

- 98.3% of newborns received a NBHS
- 1.7% (787) did not receive a NBHS
- 1.5% (690) of NBs referred the NBHS
- 83% (574) lost to diagnostic follow-up

550+ infants with inconclusive hearing status each year

Potential barriers per informal reports: family concern for taking their newborn to a medical facility, lack of or limited resources within the community, or lack of or limited family resources to attend a scheduled appointment.
