

# Oeleta Learning Center – Project Update (2025)

Here is an update about the Oeleta Learning Center in 2025. Last year, we were grateful to welcome a team from San Mateo, California who visited OLC to lead and support a Summer Camp in Kupang, Indonesia. About 100 children attended the camp each day for 10 days. The children greatly enjoyed learning new things, playing games, and spending time together in a fun and supportive environment.

During that time, the team also donated toys, school supplies, and a printer to support the center's activities. In addition, other visitors, including medical students, spent time with the children and taught them about healthy living and basic health practices.

Toward the end of 2025, we were able to purchase a new wheelchair for one of our students with disabilities. She was very excited when she tried the new wheelchair and softly said, "Ah, so good... my back pain is gone." Previously, she had been using an old wheelchair without a cushion that she inherited from her late grandfather.

We are very thankful for the kindness and support that Oeleta Learning Center has received from many individuals and organizations, including Above and Beyond Leadership and Education.

Looking ahead, we hope to build a fence around the learning center to help ensure the safety of the children during their activities. The fence will also help prevent wild animals and neighbors' animals from entering the property.
