 2. Three signed letters of recommendation from personal or professional references (ex. teacher, principal, counselor, registrar, professor, employer, coach, supervisor, etc.). Note, letters from family members, including stepfamily, do not qualify.
 3. Personal essay describing yourself, your extracurricular/volunteer activities, your career and educational goals.
 4. Resumé with employment and/or internship history, if applicable.
 5. Recent photo

Scholarships are awarded using a merit-based point system including GPA, participation in extra-curricular activities, school organizations, community, and volunteer service.
